MERCURY Mercury is at greatest western elongation on the 6th (19°).

It will become visible in low down on the morning sky before sun rise.

 $\underline{\text{VENUS}}$  Venus will not be at inferior conjuction on the 2nd. By the end of the month it will be rising abot 3 hours before the sun.

Mag. -4.6.

 $\underline{\mathsf{MARS}}$  Mars will be rising at about 22.00 in mid month. Mag. 0.3.

JUPITER Jupiter will be in conjuntion with the sun on the 17th, and will not be visible this month.

<u>SATURN</u> Saturn will be setting at about midnight in mid month. Mag.0.7

<u>URANUS & Neptune</u> Both planets are in Sagittarius, and will be visible in the evening sky only. They will be setting at about 20.00 in mid month.


### SCULPTOR

Sculptor is probably one of the most southerly constellations that you can see from our part of the northern hemisphere. The only time of the year this is possible is in November when it will be low on the southern horizen. Sculptor contains the south galactic pole, meaning the point through which a straight line would pass if drawn at right angles to the galactic plane through the center of our galaxy.

There are several good objects of interest to the amature astronomer in the area, the best being N.G.C. 253 a fine object in any instrument from binoculars upwards at about mag 7. It appears as a thick streak in binoculars, about half a degree long but through a telescope some lumpiness can be seen giving it a mottled look. This is caused by dust silhouetted against the stars of the galaxy.

Another one to look for in this group is N.G.C. 55 an irregular type galaxy which is also elongated and appears to be brighter at one end. While in this area you should look at the large and fairly rich globular cluster N.G.C. 288. It can be found a little south and east of N.G.C.253 so both can be seen in the same field of view through binoculars. N.G.C.300 is another spiral galaxy almost face on and at about mag 8-7 quite a nice object for the small telescope.

There are a few more galaxies in this area but a bit to faint for most amatures to find especially so close to the horizon.
