

OASI Child Protection/Safeguarding Guidelines

(A child is anyone under the age of 18 years)

Child protection is every adult's responsibility

To both protect children, and to protect you from any unfounded allegations:

- Children must be accompanied at all events by a parent (or guardian, or a person nominated by them)
- Treat all young people with respect and dignity
- Maintain an appropriate distance as far as possible
- Never be alone with a child or children, in a room or outside
- If any form of manual/physical support (such as at a telescope) is required the parent must always be consulted and their agreement gained
- Never communicate electronically with a child without always copying in a parent/guardian
- Never take photographs that include children without parental consent
